JUST SOME FRIENDLY REMINDERS NOW THAT WINTER IS HERE:

The Appleton Fire Department and the Appleton Water Department kindly remind you to help keep fire hydrants clear of snow this winter

Keep Fire Hydrants Clear of Snow

Every second counts in an emergency

- Remove snow and ice from the hydrant
- Clear an area approximately 3 feet around the hydrant
- Clear a path from the hydrant to the street



The Appleton Street Crew kindly requests that property owners help maintain a clear alleyway throughout the winter months. By keeping the alley clear of excess items, our snow plows can operate more efficiently, making sure the alley remains accessible and safe for everyone.

Trailer Parking Ordinance

Appleton Code 71.06 (A)

Detached trailers (including boats, campers, or utility trailers), motorhomes, and other similar recreational vehicles may not be left parked on a public road for a period beyond three days or 72 hours.



WINTER PARKING ORDINANCE

(In effect from Nov 1st thru April 1st):

NO PARKING on City Streets/Alleys - Between November 1st and April 1st, between the hours of 10:00 PM and 8:00 AM, after a snowfall with an accumulation of one (1") inch or more of snow or if a snow emergency has been declared.

If vehicle is left parked on street, you will be ticketed and towed. No warnings will be issued before a vehicle is towed. Parking may be resumed in individual streets as soon as the snow has been removed from these streets, except as may be otherwise restricted by the ordinance.
