



# Appleton Plant-A-Tree Program

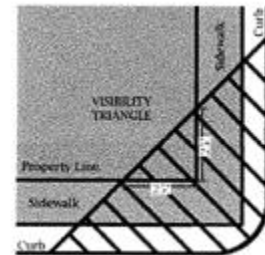
The City of Appleton is excited to offer a cost-sharing tree planting program for residents. Please read the following information and fill out the attached application form if you are interested in participating.

## Tree Types

- Only trees from the approved tree list on page 2 will be eligible for reimbursement
- Trees should be 3.5 inches or less in diameter at time of planting

## Tree Location

- Trees shall not be planted within 10' of the curb.
- Trees shall be planted 10' from the property line of any neighboring property.
- When a property has a sidewalk, trees must be planted 5' from the sidewalk on either the house side or street side (if you can also meet the 10' from curb standard).
- Trees shall not be planted under power lines, under the electric service line from the pole to your house or where it would block light from streetlights.
- Trees shall not be planted in front of ground mounted transformers, cable boxes or other utility boxes
- Trees shall not be planted over the water or sewer shut offs or service lines.
- Corner lots shall not have trees planted within the visibility triangle, 25' from the corner property lines.



## Other Program Guidelines

- Cost sharing is up to 50% of the cost of the tree
- Applicant must complete the application and allow the city to verify the location before proceeding with planting the tree.
- Each property is limited to 2 trees
- Property owners are responsible for planting and maintaining the tree
- If funds budgeted for the year are used up, the city reserves the right to deny tree program requests.
